Health & Safety Requirements

We ask that you adhere to these requirements if you plan to attend our in-person worship services. We will have people to help ensure these protocols are being followed, but we would prefer avoiding any awkward conversations.





BEFORE ARRIVAL

- RSVP with Nona in the church office or on our church's website by Friday afternoon (bit.ly/3bXWGR6). We only have seating for 35 people, and space will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. We don't want to have to turn anyone away at the door.
- Pre-screen yourself. Do not come to church if you are exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms. It doesn't matter if you are 100% certain that it's just allergies or some other minor issue, please stay home and take advantage of our live stream.



UPON ARRIVAL

- Properly put on a mask. It must cover your nose and mouth at all times while inside. If you forget a mask, one will be provided.
- A temperature check will be required for entry. Your temperature must be below 100F.
- Get a spritz of hand sanitizer.
- Enter into the sanctuary through the main lobby doors.



AFTER ENTERING

- Maintain at least six feet of distance between you and other people not in your household.
- Sit only in a designated, non-taped portion of the pews. The seats are staggerd, every other pew.
- Only one person allowed in the restroom at a time. The surfaces need to be wiped down after every use.
- Exit the sanctuary through the side lobby door.
